

Drainage Board

February 01, 2010 – 11:00 am

Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Rininger, Gogel, Surveyor Herron, and Attorney Robinson were present.

Minutes

01/15/2010 minutes; Logsdon asked for Lincoln Trail to be designated in the minutes as Lincoln Trail Road. Rininger made a motion to approve the minutes. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

Surveyor's Report

Project Delays – Surveyor Herron reported that meetings with the contractors to discuss projects on Crooked Creek (North and South), and Anderson River were delayed due to rain.

Garrett Creek – Herron sent the forms in to request permitting from the Corp of Engineers for Garrett Creek. Logsdon complimented Herron on the paperwork submitted.

Pigeon Creek – Herron stated work was delayed on Pigeon Creek due to high water.

FEMA

Herron reported that he will be applying for another one-year extension to spend the FEMA funds. Logsdon asked if crop reimbursement can be paid with the funds. Herron said he is working with the Corp of Engineers and they are helping with the extension and trying to get crop reimbursement included. Gogel said some farmers could be asked not to plant in some areas so work can be done during planting season. Herron agreed and he said most farmers will allow work to be done.

DR – 2 Grant

Logsdon discussed the DR – 2 Grant and said since only 3% of the grant can be used to pay for the required grant administrator, it would be better for the county to stay with the FEMA funds as long as extensions are being granted.

Soil and Water

Herron discussed the “Two Stage Ditch” project that Soil and Water would like to try. Soil and Water will be paying for the project. He will report back with more information.

Special Meeting

If the wet weather lets up, a special meeting will be called on February 16, at 2:00 pm to open bids.

Spraying Contract

Robinson discussed the drafting of an ordinance to contract with land owners to spray drains that have been cleaned by the county. Herron said the county could provide the chemical. Logsdon asked Robinson to work with Herron on developing the ordinance. Logsdon said he will discuss the contract with the Drainage Advisory Board.

CR 975N and CR 400W

Logsdon asked Herron and Painter to look at the intersection of CR 975N and CR 400W. The roads get under water after a rain. Herron will report back at the next meeting.

Gogel made a motion to adjourn. Rininger seconded. All in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 11:29 am.
