Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Rininger, Gogel, Surveyor Herron and Attorney Robinson were present.

Minutes

04/07/2009 minutes; Rininger made a motion to approve the minutes. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

Weber Property

David Weber, who owns a home in Richland, asked for a variance to install a septic system where the perimeter drain will be within the 75 foot right-of-way. The Health Department has approved the plans. Gogel made a motion to approve. Rininger seconded. All in favor.

Lake Drain

Surveyor Herron discussed Lake Drain and how the sides are sliding into areas which were previously cleaned out. He is investigating solutions to the problem.

Surveyor Report

Huffman Drain- Herron reported that section of Huffman Drain off Silverdale Road was clogged by debris. He said a contractor had a backhoe on the neighboring property and offered to clean it out for \$100. Herron had him clear the debris.

FEMA Aid – If approved, FEMA will reimburse the county for any taxpayer money which was used to clean drains which were blocked with debris from the recent storms. Herron took pictures of the blockages on

Crooked Creek and submitted them to FEMA. Logsdon stated that the county needs a letter from NCRS stating that they will not fund the project at this time, because FEMA will not pay if NCRS is willing to pay. Fuchs, of Soil and Water, will ask the NCRS for the letter. Logsdon stated that the help Fuchs gives the county is greatly appreciated.

Huffman Drain at CR 200 – Herron stated that the Highway Department cleared out a large log jam beside CR 200.

Sam Finch Drain – Herron is meeting with the Grandview Town Council on Thursday to ask for support in clearing the Sam Finch Drain. He will ask them to replace two culverts, and seed and straw the lots. Herron stated that if Grandview approves, he would like to see it done in July or August when the water table is down.

Huffman Drain North of CR 200N – Herron said he would like to start working on the specs for Huffman Drain north of CR 200N. He said the landowner has agreed to seed and straw the area. Rininger made a motion to have Herron draw up specs on Huffman Drain north of CR 200N. Gogel seconded. All in favor.

Orchard Road North of CR 900 – Herron reported that DNR has given the county permission to discover why the water crosses the road on Orchard Rd North of CR 900, but the water is too high right now. Herron stated that he will report back to DNR before any work would begin to correct the problem.

Johnson Farms – Don Johnson is concerned about a culvert which was installed which diverted water on to his property. Herron will research and report back to the board.

Stormwater Ordinance

Logsdon asked if the industries which may move into the county will have to adhere to the Stormwater Ordinance passed by the commissioners. Lueken said yes, any future industry or business will have to adhere to Ordinance 2007-10.

Gogel made a motion to adjourn. Logsdon seconded. All in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 11:47 am.
