Meeting called to order by President Logsdon. Members Logsdon, Rininger, Gogel, Surveyor Herron and Attorney Robinson were present.

Minutes

Bid Opening- Isaac Wright Drain (Vinton Woods)

Surveyor Herron stated that the Surveyor's Estimate on the Isaac Wright Drain (Vinton Woods) was \$4,500. Attorney Robinson opened and read the bids as follows:

Herron recommended accepting the low bid. Rininger made a motion to award the project to Sam's Backhoe Service. Gogel seconded. All in favor. Logsdon stated that all of the landowner agreements have been signed.
